NOTICE

(To be read out aloud to all the candidates)

All the candidates appearing for the term End Examination Theory and Practical are hereby informed to take a note of the following:

1. All the candidates will be frisked physically to ensure that they are not carrying items those are barred in the Examination Block.
2. Candidates are advised to wear simple half sleeves shirt or t-shirt, but not having a big button or any badge which could be used to hide any devices.
3. Candidates should wear the Slipper or Sandals, Not the Shoes Which Are Not Allowed in the Examination Centers.
4. Candidates are advised not to bring the items which are not allowed the Examination Hall as there is no Safe Keeping Place.
5. Candidate should not wear torn jeans / trousers/ shorts and also with multiple pockets.
6. It is mandatory for the candidate to bring HALL TICKET AND IDENTITY CARD ISSUED BY THE INSTITUTE, produce them on demand and keep them visible during the entire duration of examination.
- 7. CANDIDATES SHALL HAVE TO PAY FINE OF RS.100/- FOR NOT BRINGING THE IDENTITY CARD AND/OR HALL TICKET ISSUED BY THE INSTITUTE.**


List of Barred Items:

Candidates are not allowed to bring the following list of items while coming in the Examination Block:

- Any stationary item such as bits of papers, textual material (written or printed), Pen Drive, Writing Pad, Log Table, Programmable Calculator, Scanner/ Electronic Pen etc.
- Any communication devices, for example, Bluetooth, Mobile Phone, Earphones, Pager, Microphone, Health Band etc.
- Any SMART Watch/Wrist Watch, Camera etc.
- Items such as Goggles, Wallet, Handbags, Cap etc.
- Any food either opened or closed.
- Any other items that can be used for hiding Bluetooth device, camera etc.

In case any candidate is found in possession of any of the barred items mentioned in the above list as well as those displayed in the Examination block inside the Examination center, it will be considered as use of unfair means and action will be taken against the candidate by the relevant provisions.

Kindly note these guidelines are issued for candidates to curb malpractices during the examination and should be followed diligently.
